

## FROM THE MORGUE

### Classic Articles From Police Gazettes Gone By

The following article appeared while notorious criminal John Dillinger was still alive and on the run. In it the *Police Gazette* predicts Dillinger would likely be given up by a woman and die from gunfire. Two months later he would be shot and killed by Federal agents after being sold out by the famous "woman in red." (Bold type is in the original.)

## John Dillinger

The amazingly daring exploits of this modern Jesse James are common knowledge to readers of daily newspapers. Beginning with the memorable Crown Point, Indiana "wooden pistol" jail break of March 3, and marked, up to the present date, with the blood of six victims, the deadly game of "Find Dillinger" goes on. Five thousand men are scouring the Northwest with orders to shoot on sight. Indian guides are stalking the little known trails of upper Minnesota, goaded on by the offer of "much money" for the "bad white man" . . . dead or alive . . . preferably dead.

The Federal Government is no longer interested in seeing John Dillinger stand trial. Assistant Attorney General Joseph B. Keenan, chief-of-staff of the Federal war on crime, ponders at his Washington desk, nervously fingers every report of the Dillinger hunt and says: "I don't know when or where we will get Dillinger but . . . I hope we will get him under such circumstances that the Government won't have to stand the expense of trial." Fat-faced, cleft-jawed Joe Keenan wants John Dillinger's body. So does the entire Middle-West . . . riddled with bullets!

Thus far, the expense of the search has been more than \$200,000. Enough to feed 400 starving families for a year. Six men have breathed their last and the end has not yet come.

John Dillinger is a pug-nosed, crafty-eyed young man of 31. His face reveals none of the courage and strength that his escapades demand. A weak chin and a small, ash-brown moustache brand him unmistakably. Physiognomists (students of facial characteristics) call him a "fear villain." Studying his pictured likenesses they claim he has no "guts," but only the blind, moronic lack of fear of a maniac. "It is not that Dillinger is so clever," a prominent Columbia University sociologist informed the POLICE GAZETTE, "but rather that the men who are hunting him are so lacking in ingenuity."

Digging deep below the surface of John Dillinger's saga of blood, we find the undercurrent of women rushing headlong in each and every escapade. The theory that he "loved" his way out of Crown Point at the expense of the jail's woman sheriff, is still a pet theory of this writer. At Mercer, Minn., Dillinger left three girls behind after breaking through a cordon of officers. At Saint Paul, Minn., Evelyn Frechette, a beautiful half-French, half-Indian cabaret performer, helped him escape when police raided his apartment. Later she was captured in a Chicago cafe.

Sex and bullets make up the essence of Dillinger's life ever since, as a boy of 19, he was sentenced to the Indiana State Penitentiary for robbery. And always, the women are young, good-looking and possessed of an overabundance of sex appeal.

In the same category as a movie idol, John Dillinger has now become the apple of every cheap mill-town girl's eye. To be loved by this engaging killer would be heaven. To be held in his arms for the briefest of moments, a thrill divine.

But somehow, studying John Dillinger's trail of guns and girls, the POLICE GAZETTE is con-

vinced he will meet an inglorious end through the ramifications of the sex he worships. The POLICE GAZETTE has been reliably informed that a number of female deputies are assisting in the man-hunt, reasoning that if bullets won't get Dillinger, sex will!

#### *The Mighty Death Pop*

Even though ICP has been around since the late '80s in local Detroit, they have always been a mixed bag. Either you love them or you hate them. We on the other hand are both full bore Juggalos and have been long time for years. iDB is 33, started listening when he was 19, and Spart is in the same boat pretty much. This new release has been much anticipated and just came out on August 14th even though it was available early for those who attended the 2012 Gathering of the Juggalos.

Every main album ICP has dropped has been called a Jokers Card. The original six dropped between 1991 and 2002/04 and *The Mighty Death Pop* is the 2nd Card off the 2nd Deck (musical reboot so to speak for a new generation of Ninjas who were too young the first time around). Each Jokers Card is a manifestation of a reflection of yourself. *The Mighty Death Pop* is your personal surprise party of doom. Your life is the balloon. When it pops you're done. Question is are you going to be dumb enough to pop your own balloon? Suicide, drug overdose, YouTube stunt gone wrong, don't try this at home warning ignored. Or even fate itself takes over in the form of a car accident, murder, crate of bananas falls on you, etc. *The Death Pop* is your sudden black-out.

ICP has provided over an hour of songs reflecting the messages and wishes of the MDP on three versions (White Pop, Red Pop, Black Pop) each with its own bonus CD containing over 60 minutes of additional material for a grand total of four new albums. So just buy all three versions, keep the bonus albums and hook friends up with your extra copies. The main album contains a nice mix of different styles, comedy, darkness, and wickedness with tracks like "Chris Benoit," "Night of the Chainsaw," a nice Chris Brown diss called "Shooting Stars," "Juggalo Juice," "Daisies," and "Where's God?" The first bonus CD is called Mike E. Clark's Musical Emporium, which is remixes, B sides, and collabs with artists like Ice Cube, Swollen Members, Three 6 Mafia, and Color Me Badd. Yes, ICP and CMB throw down on this disc. The next bonus CD is an hour long version of *Too Short's Freaky Tales*. An hour of ho flows. The 3rd bonus disc is called *Chopped Smothered and Chunked*. It's a bunch of COVER SONGS with ICP knocking out classics like House of Pain's "Jump Around", Christina's "Beautiful" and even the theme to kids show *Yo Gabba Gabba*.

This being ICP's 12th major studio release only shows that they have come along way in over 20 years. And despite not having the respect of the music industry, commercial radio play or even love from MTV (too busy making money off kids getting prego), they have conquered and dominated the underground scene. Their annual Gathering of the Juggalos for over 12 years has, like it or not, become the new Woodstock. They came into this business poor, broke, and starving. Today they bankroll over four million dollars a year, so their kids will never have to go hungry. We think they earned their place as one of greatest of all times.
