Fastest Speed for a Towed Skateboard

Steffen Eliassen of Norway achieved a speed of 93.2 mph standing on a skateboard while being towed by a Tesla Roadster Sport driven by Oystein Westlie at Rudskogen Motorpark, Norway.

Most Credits in One Movie and Most Stunts by a Living Actor

Jackie Chan carried out 15 of the major creative movie-making roles for the film Chinese Zodiac, which released in Hong Kong in 2012. Chan performed everything from director, writer, actor, and producer all the way down to catering coordinator. He breaks the previous record of 11 credits set by Robert Rodriguez. Chan also received the Guinness World Records title for Most Stunts by a Living Actor, a reflection of his nearly 50 years in movies performing all his own stunts.

Most Goals in a Calendar Year

Barcelona football (soccer) star Lionel Messi struck 86 goals during 2012, breaking the long-standing record held by Gerd Mueller.
