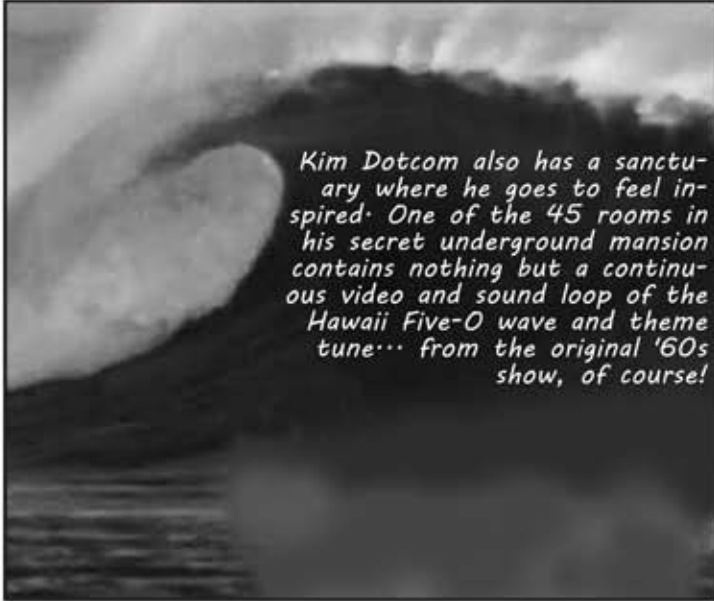

Loudest Crowd Roar at a Sports Stadium

Fans at CenturyLink Field in Seattle set the record during a Seattle Seahawks game against the San Francisco 49ers, with a peak reading of 136.6 dbA—nearly the same as a jet engine 100 feet away.

Largest Collection of Star Wars Memorabilia

Steve Sansweet of Petaluma, CA, keeps a collection of an estimated 300,000 unique Star Wars items, including outfits and props from the films, a full complement of the original action figures, plus Star Wars video games and pinball machines. Only 90,546 items have been accurately audited and catalogued, but already it's three times more than the previous Guinness World Records holder.

World Record Contortionist

Leilani Franco of the United Kingdom has set numerous contortion records, including the **Most Full-Body Revolutions Maintaining a Chest Stand in One Minute** (25). She also accomplished the **Fastest Human Backbend Walk**, traveling just shy of 22 yards in 10.05 seconds; and covered the same distance for the **Fastest 20 Meters in a Contortion Roll**, coming in at 17.47 seconds.

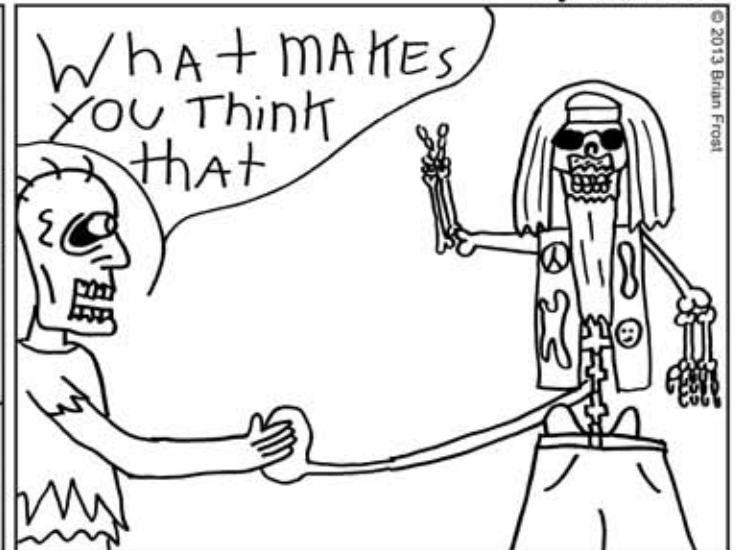
Largest Rideable Motorcycle

Fabio Reggiani of Italy designed and built, with a team of eight, a rideable motorcycle measuring 16 feet 8.78 inches from the ground to the top of the handlebars, 32 feet 10.92 inches long, and 8 feet 2.40 inches wide. It weighs approximately 11,000 pounds and is powered by a 5.7L V8 engine, running at 280 HP with 3 forward gears plus reverse.
