Fastest 0-to-186mph by a Production Car

A Hennessey Venom GTA went from a standstill to 186mph (300km/h) in 13.63 seconds on an Ellington Field Airport runway in Houston, Texas. The car sports a 7-litre V8 engine capable of 1,244bhp.

Largest Simultaneous Car Tire Burn-Out

69 cars burnt 138 tires at a record attempt in Exhibition Park, Canberra, Australia. A combined 35,000 horsepower was utilized during the 30-second record setter, which saw billows of pink, orange and red smoke ascend to the sky from specially made burnout tires.

**Largest Upper-Arm Circumference
CATEGORY DISCONTINUED**

Following is a statement from Guinness World Records regarding this category: "After a thorough investigation involving external expertise, Guinness World Records has decided to rest the record category for largest upper arm circumference; the current record being held by Mustafa Ismail (USA). After publication of Mr. Ismail's record in September 2012, we received a number of calls from the public querying whether it was possible to achieve Mr. Ismail's result without the use of body-enhancing substances, in particular Synthol. Guinness World Records would like to make it absolutely clear that it has seen no medical evidence to support any claim that Mr. Ismail used Synthol or any other body-enhancing substance. However, after extensive consultation and advice from the appropriate governing bodies, Guinness World Records has taken the decision to no longer accept claims for largest upper arm circumference on the grounds that there are too many evidentiary variables to ensure a declarative benchmark that is firmly beyond dispute."
